## Downloading IEA Datasets via WDS (Quick guide)

Navigate to <u>IEA Datasets</u> and select the data sets you would like to access and click on **Access on WDS.**

Free data sets are preceded with orange folder icons; paying data sets you have subscribed to are marked with a star.


Note that Emissions Factors and Monthly Gas Data Service are not included in the ISP.




There are 2 ways to access the data on the WDS portal:

  - Then click on the required data set (see below):




- Then select each of the dimensions and the elements you need:




Once you have selected the data you need, click on Show Table:



- When you have the table, you can arrange it as you wish:




Once you have the table arranged as you want, you can download into excel or another format:



## 2. Download full databases (and work offline)

## Step 1: Download and install the Beyond 20/20 browser software onto your computer.

You should download it directly from the website before trying to access the data for the first time. To download, click on the button "Download Beyond 20/20 Browser" in the upper right-hand corner of the screen:




## Step 2: Download the data files in .IVT format.


Highlight the folder in the left-hand column. There should be a gold star on the folder icon showing that you have access to that on-line data service.

To download individual data files, click on the little box with the red arrow to the right of each data file in the right-hand column. All the files should be downloaded into the same directory for ease of use. Documentation can also be downloaded in PDF format.





Once you have downloaded the IVTs you can save as Excel, CSV, TXT etc. by clicking on File, Save As...



Step 3: Once the software and data files are downloaded, you no longer need to use the internet. Open the data files using the software and work off-line.
