Welcome from the Director of Careers

I am delighted to share with you the achievements of our 2017 graduates from our portfolio of Finance Master's programmes; MSc Finance, MSc Finance & Accounting, MSc Investment & Wealth Management, MSc Risk Management & Financial Engineering. On average, 94% of our 390 finance graduates were employed within three months of graduation. This is a magnificent reflection of their quality and skill set.

Our graduates are highly valued by our corporate partners; they were recruited by a range of top employers with Goldman Sachs, Morgan Stanley, BCG, HSBC, Nomura, Accenture, The Boston Consulting Group, Citi, UBS, Deutche Bank, PwC, Credit Suisse, Barclays, and Deloitte all hiring two or more of our students.

Our students are amongst the brightest and the best. They come from diverse academic and geographical environments, but they all share a passion for understanding the key drivers of modern finance. Our finance Master's programmes are intellectually rigorous and quantitative, covering a broad range of relevant topics to prepare students for their chosen finance career.

In this report, we share details of our graduates' achievements, including the sectors and regions that they are working in, all over the world.

As we celebrate the 20th anniversary of our MSc Finance, it is pleasing to see that this long-established programme continues to deliver excellent employment prospects for our graduates. This year we have seen an increase in the salaries our MSc Finance students command, with an average salary of £44,433 which is equivalent to US \$67,856 when PPP is applied to take into account the international spread of our graduates.

It has been a pleasure to support all of our finance students and our corporate partners by matching the roles and talent they were seeking. We wish them well and look forward to supporting them further in the future.



Our students and graduates are a diverse community of brilliant minds from a number of different backgrounds and nationalities.




MSc Finance Employment data








