For the 2021/22 season Imperial Athletes was a joint funding arrangement between ICU (Students Union) and Move Imperial (University)

- Funding from College £159,000
- Funding from ICU £241,184 (as part of the block grant from College to ICU)
- Balance was made up from memberships costs and external income streams

We operated a central funding model that meant some costs remained in a central budget code, but all expenditure was related to student clubs:
