

Dr Gloria Borley (Geology 1960, PhD 1962) joined Imperial as a student in 1957 after starting her career as a secretary and later moving into accounting. She had left school early, following the death of her father, and it was not until meeting and marrying James Borley that she and her husband both decided to pursue higher education. After completing her undergraduate degree in Geology and PhD in Geochemistry, Dr Borley went on become one of the first female lecturers at Imperial's Royal School of Mines. She remained at Imperial, overseeing Mineralogy and Petrology, until her retirement. Dr Borley passed away in 2016, leaving a generous legacy gift (of £1,070,521) to support neurological research at Imperial. She had made the pledge in memory of her husband, James, who she lost to Alzheimer's disease.

Dr Borley described the impact of her husband's condition as "catastrophic". The experience left her determined to lend her support to neurological research at Imperial. At the time of making her legacy pledge, she said: "Imperial constantly pushes the boundaries of progress in science. My decision to set up this scholarship fund has been extremely cathartic for me. It gives me a sense of relief that something positive can emerge from such a sad experience. My legacy will enable gifted young students to continue making important progress in neurological research."
