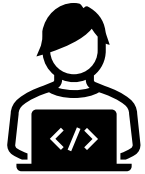


## Your baby's data are important!

Neonatal unit staff record data into your baby's Electronic Patient Record



With the approval of the UK Health Research Authority, data are sent securely to the Neonatal Data Analysis Unit at Imperial College London to form the National Neonatal Research Database, and used subject to regulatory approval for multiple purposes to improve care
