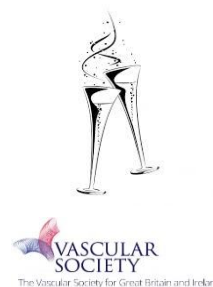
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EVRA INVESTIGATOR MEETING


EVRA Extension Phase

October 2018 – March 2019

The extension phase is now underway with sites collecting follow-up data from trial participants. Each site will have an 'Extension Training Visit' from the EVRA co-ordination office prior to data collection. Please check when each participant is due for follow-up, and liaise with Jocelyn if there are any queries.

Also a reminder of the importance of collecting the EQ-5D, SF-36 and AVVQ health questionnaires to measure our participants quality of life. In order to minimise the amount of missing data, if these are not returned by post, please send a reminder or collect via the telephone where possible. Thank-you!

Data Entry & PI Final Sign-Off

As research sites start to enter follow-up data onto InForm, the EVRA trial office will be cleaning the data for analysis, raising any queries as we go. We will be in touch with any queries, but thank-you to all for keeping data entry up to date to ensure all data is entered and queries answered by the 31st March 2019!



A quick note that once data entry is complete, PIs will be required to sign-off the extension data to confirm it is accurate. We will be in touch closer to the time to remind sites how to complete this.
