

POSTER SUBMISSION INFORMATION

Authors should submit a short abstract of a maximum of 300 words that describes the main contributions of the poster **via email to sargent.centre@imperial.ac.uk** with the email subject name as "Poster: Author". Submitted abstracts will be judged on their significance, originality and methodological quality.

DEADLINE: Poster abstracts should be sent no later than 8th September 2023 (extended from 1st September).

Authors of accepted poster proposals that are received by 1st September will be informed by email during week beginning 4th September.

Authors of accepted poster proposals that are received by 8th September will be informed by email during week beginning 11th September.

Presenters will be provided instructions for preparing the posters.

Poster abstracts will be shared with Forum attendees.
