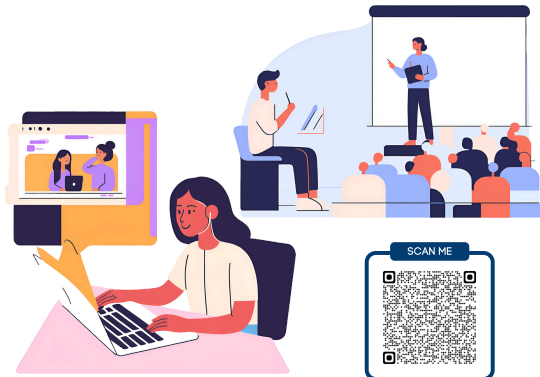


How has the transition from school to university affected your approach to in-class learning?
